Gloves and gear will be provided. All you have to do is turn up and bring along your enthusiasm!!

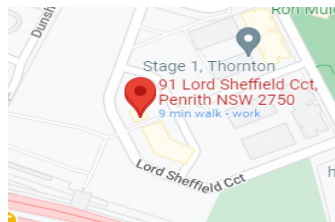
